CONTROLLING FOR GROWTH



Background & History

Excellent controlling capacities and qualified controlling personnel are key factors for a company's success especially in China. While operations in China are becoming increasingly complex and competition is intensifying, there is a shortage of qualified controllers as well as a lack of knowledge of professional controlling practices.

The Sino-German Controlling Forum 2014, which is jointly organized by the German Chamber of Commerce Shanghai, the Controller Akademie and Shanghai De Chen Management and supported by DUSA European Association Suzhou and the International Controller Association (ICV), provides a platform of networking and exchange for both financial and non-financial executives and professionals in German and Chinese business communities who would like to improve their controlling practice supporting future growth and performance excellence in China.

The first forum was held in Shanghai in October 2013. It was coorganized by Shanghai De Chen Consulting, CA Controller Akademie, the International Controller Association (ICV), and the Shanghai National Accounting Institute. The original idea for the forum was born in dialog between Dr. Zhen Huang from Shanghai De Chen Consulting, Mr. Bernd Pichler from Volkswagen China, and Prof. Dr. Utz Schaeffer from the German Business School WHU Koblenz. They are activists of "Controlling in China", an initiative with the objective to promote the dialog between German and Chinese professionals interested in modern, efficient management accounting and controlling practice.
